

La Carriere Stables and Tack Shop
Yard Rules

These rules are provided to ensure the yard operates safely and efficiently at all times, and apply to all users.

- All horses and ponies shall have third party insurance.
- Smoking is **only** permitted on the 'Veranda' area, outside the shop.
- All horses and ponies must be attended to and skipped out by 10:00am on DIY days. Staff are to be advised in advance if this is not possible. If not, the stable will be attended to, and a charge made.
- **All muck must be stacked neatly in the trailers, not just tipped.** If muck is not stacked neatly, a charge will be made to all liveries to cover yard staff's time to make good.
- All horses and ponies will be wormed by yard staff regularly with the appropriate wormer for the time of the year.
- No outside parties will be permitted to look after horses/ponies whilst the owner is on holiday due to routine and security issues.
- No vehicles will be allowed on the fields without prior permission.
- DIY Liveries will be required to clear their field of muck a minimum of once a week. If not it will be cleared and a charge will be made.
- All muck must be bagged and left outside your field; yard staff will collect.
- Field gates must be closed even if the field is empty.
- **No running is permitted anywhere on the yard.**
- If your horse/pony makes a mess whilst tied up you **MUST** clean it up.
- Head collars and haynets should be left tied neatly on the yard whilst riding.
- The hose and drain in the main yard is only be used for filling water buckets.
- Haynets should only be soaked in the washstand area.
- A washstand area is provided for bathing/hosing of horses/ponies. No other areas can be used. The washstand area **MUST** be left clean and tidy after use.
- All minors not undertaking tuition or supervised activities are the responsibility of the parent or guardian and not of the riding school.
- If your horse is a known kicker it must be supervised if tied on the yard, or it shall remain in its stable.
- You must keep the area around your stable clean and tidy and free from litter.
- Bikes are not to be left by stables and areas where they may impede emergency evacuation.
- Hi visibility clothing for horse and rider must be worn at all times during the winter months.
- Tea/coffee is available during working hours but it would be appreciated if you would leave enough milk for the next day. The area is to always be left clean and tidy, will all cups/mugs and cutlery washed properly.
