Open to any novice horse/rider. Open to Juniors or Seniors. This section is for young riders, young horses and those who lack confidence.

- CLASS 1 A. **Leading Rein (Cross Poles)**
 B. **Trotters (Cross Poles)**

No fillers, first jump pole on the ground, then a cross pole, and then a bigger cross pole and finally ending up at a 40cm straight pole. Open to any age on or off lead rein for youngsters and inexperienced horses or rider. Last fence (the 40cm straight pole) is optional for an extra 3 points.
- CLASS 4 **The Cross Pole Challenge**
All fences as cross poles at a maximum height of 40cm

- CLASS 5 **Minimus Championship Qualifying Competition.**
Maximum height in the first round 50cms. No fillers.

Points awarded are 3 for 1st place, 2 for 2nd place and 1 for 3rd place. Where placings are shared, points will also be shared. There must be three or more competitors to achieve maximum points. If less then points will be reduced ie 2 points for 1st place and 1 point for 2nd place.
